- Attend daily safety huddles and present monthly safety meetings
- Continuously support the Zero Harm Vision of Foran with all employees, contractors, and service providers
- Coach and mentor supervisory team
- Organize, schedule, and conduct mine rescue sessions as per provincial requirements
