You will be an active participant on the site Emergency Response team and be an active Mine Rescue Volunteer.

- Ensure site establishment including box cut and mine portal are constructed as per Engineered design
- Actively participate in Operational Readiness Planning
- Create and maintain Action Logs for all critical tasks on project
- Act as a liaison between the contractor, company, and the consulting teams
- Project controls for the entire project – month end accounting of contractor/supplier spending vs budget
- Workplace inspections and audits
- Work collaboratively with the Foran Safety/Mine Rescue Coordinator to develop policies and procedures
- Participate in Formal Risk Assessments
- Ensure compliance to Mining Regulations and Occupational Health and Safety Regulations
