Reporting jointly to the VP Engineering and working closely with the rest of the management team, the IT Specialist plans and implements enterprise IT projects and oversees day-to-day IT operational delivery. This includes hardware and software lifecycle management, system network support, identity and access management, telecom and VOIP, on-premises computer, cloud services, LAN/WAN connectivity, end-user computing (desktop, laptop, tablet), end-user provisioning and mobility. Initially based in our Saskatoon office, this position will evolve to be a hybrid office/site based position.

- Leads the implementation of new technology and maintenance of existing technology
- Maintains and monitors daily operations of infrastructure and technology, analyzing work, developing standards, setting deadlines and following up on execution
- Oversee data and IT security
- Develop company wide IT standards and protocols
- Effectively track assets and software distribution
- Monitors system life cycles, ensures specifications and functionality support business objectives and architecture decisions.
- Collaborates with various departments on projects and leads the implementation of projects.
- Collaborates with vendors in purchasing equipment and services, supports issues and problem resolution.
