The **Occupational Health Nurse** will be part of the Health and Safety Team and required to promote safe, healthy working conditions by identifying hazards and risks in the workplace and developing strategies to mitigate them.

Job Responsibilities:

- Provide primary care and on-site treatment as required
- Conduct and/or coordinate various workplace occupational health assessments that may include Pre-Employment Screening, Respirator Fit testing, Vaccinations, Chest X-Rays, Drug and Alcohol Testing and Audiometric testing
- Administer and manage disability management including modified and return to work programs for both Occupational and Non-Occupational events
- In coordination with Human Resources, manage WCB claims
- Administration of employee and contractor medical records
- Coordinate Standard First Aid, CPR and AED Training including Mental Health First Aid Training onsite and in local communities
- Collaborates with site leadership and key partners in promoting employee health and wellbeing by developing programs to inform, educate and advocate positive lifestyle choices
- Participate in initiatives and contribute to Employee Wellness Committee and Crisis Management teams
- Assess health related training needs and implement relevant training programs
